

**LAKE PARK CITY COUNCIL**  
**AUGUST 8, 2011**

The following are the minutes as recorded by the City Clerk and are subject to council approval at the next regular meeting on 9-12-11.

Lake Park City Council met in regular session and for a Public Hearing on 8-8-11 at City Hall. Mayor Engel opened the Public Hearing at 7:00PM with the Pledge of Allegiance. Public Hearing is for Vacation of Alley Portion of Alley I Block 7, Chrysler's Subdivision of Lot 1 of Knox and Van Steenburg's Plat, Lake Park, Iowa; and Vacation of Alley Adjacent to East Side of Lot 9, First Addition to City of Lake Park, Iowa. Members present: Packebush, Woods, Heikens and Clerk Palmer. Arriving later: Eggers; absent: Reekers. Also present: Tom Underwood, Gary Taber, Jeff Jacobsma, Joe & Ann Hoover, Brandon Ehret, Jason Eygabroad and Herb Stewart.

Being no questions or comments, Mayor closed Public Hearing at 7:02PM.

Mayor called regular meeting to order at 7:02PM.

Moved by Packebush/Heikens to approve the consent agenda with the addition of Approve Johnny's Pub Transfer of Class C Liquor License for 24 hrs to 903 South Market; and includes: Minutes from July 11, 2011 Meeting; Financial Reports; Approve Bills for Payment; Accept Jamie Johnson's Resignation from Park & Recreation Board; Accept Leon Collins' Resignation from Library Board; Resolution #9-11 Approving City Street Financial Report for 10/11; Approve/Deny Silver Lanes Class C Liquor License Renewal and Sunday Sales; and Approve/Deny Johnny's Pub 24 Hr Outdoor Service Permit. Moved by Packebush/Heikens to approve the consent agenda with the addition and approving all license renewals and permits. Roll call vote: AYES – Packebush, Woods and Heikens. NAYS – none. Motion carried and resolution duly adopted. All bills are listed at end of minutes with recap of totals by fund. By this mention all bills become part of these 8-8-11 minutes.

Moved by Woods/Heikens to approve regular agenda; all ayes.

REPORTS: Police report included in packets and council asked about Farmer Appreciation Day. Ehret on hand to give street report and discussed Ave B West that needs to be addressed in the future. Library report was included in packets. Eggers arrived.

OLD BUSINESS: Eygabroad on hand with copies of graphs of average daily and monthly sanitary sewer flow charts. Due to the heavy rainfalls in July, the flows were higher than normal. Included in packets, were quotes for either leasing or purchasing flow meters. Eygabroad felt that smoke testing should be done since the relining project is completed to help city determine where the ground water etc is getting into the sanitary sewer lines. A letter to all residents and businesses will be sent out in the near future explaining possible illegal sump pump hookups etc and that inspections will be done by the city crew and administrator. No decision on flow meters at this time.

NEW BUSINESS: Moved by Heikens/ Woods to approve Pay Estimate #6 to Municipal Pipe Tool Co for \$110,479.73; all ayes.

Mayor appointed Lisa Bowden to the Park & Recreation Board to fill the vacancy with the term ending 12-31-11. Moved by Heikens/Eggers to approve mayor's appointment; all ayes.

Mayor reported no one for the Library Board appointment yet; will be on Sept. agenda.

Council discussion, mayor's report and administrator's report were last items on agenda.
