Freedom Rock & Veteran's Memorial-- Lake Park has been given a great honor to be the host of a "Freedom Rock" on the Freedom Rock Tour.

Heritage Square-- The Lake Park Historical Society has restored some of Lake Park's original buildings at Heritage Square.

Silver Lake-- The lake is 1,066 acres (1.67 square miles) in size with 9.6 miles of shoreline. There are three hard-surfaced boat ramps around the lake for boaters to use.

Camping-- There are two campgrounds around Lake Park for you to pitch your tent or park your RV. Both campgrounds are located on Silver Lake.

Golf-- Silver Lake Country Club is a fun, yet challenging, nine hole golf course adjacent to beautiful Silver Lake.

Disc Golf-- In 2012, the City of Lake Park constructed a disc golf course around the east side of the city park. If you can throw a Frisbee and you like to have fun, you can play disc golf.

Parks -- Located along the lake, Silver Lake City Park provides a scenic area for family picnics, reunions or just a place for the kids to play, also located at the City Park is the Knox Cabin. This was the first home in Lake Park.

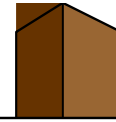
2010 Census: Population of 1105

CARDBOARD RECYCLING

Cardboard recycling is once again available at the City shed. We have contracted with Shamrock Recycling to provide us this service. All cardboard will have to be flattened in order to fit in the slots. There are no lids to open and close with this receptacle. At this time there will be no additional charge to the residents. We ask everyone to be good stewards of this service and to only place cardboard in the receptacle and to not place any garbage near the recycle bin. We will be monitoring the area for any abuse of the service and offenders may be prosecuted. Keep in mind that it is a free service not to be abused.
