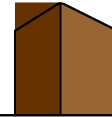

WINTER REMINDER

Parking Snow Ban—Between Nov 1st and Apr 1st no vehicle shall be left standing or parked on City streets between the hours of 2:00am and 6:00am or at any time during the day or night in which snow removal operations are in progress. Fines for the 1st offense will be \$25.00. For all subsequent offenses the fine will be \$50.00

It is a violation of city code to cause snow and ice from private property to be placed in the street.

Be sure to check to see if your furnace filter needs replacement. Stop in the Utility office to pick up your replacement filters. Limit 2 per year
