

CITY REMINDERS

The grass ordinance which requires grass/weeds to be less than 10" on the 1st & 15th of each month does not only apply to your grass. **This also applies to overgrown brush and weeds that may be growing around the home, curbs, utility poles, fence lines, etc.** We hope that you will take pride in the appearance of your home or place of residence.

Under ordinance, it is the responsibility of the property owner to keep the trees that overhang the street trimmed to 15ft above the street surface. This also applies to alleys. Take a few minutes to check your trees.
