WHEN TO APPLY:

- * Elderly(60 & over) & disabled:
Oct 1, 2020 to Apr 30, 2021
- * All other household:
Nov 1, 2020 to Apr 30, 2021

WHAT TO TAKE:

- * Proof of income (for all household members age 19 and over) Check stubs from the previous 30 days, award letter from Social Security or 2019 tax return
- * Social Security numbers for all household members
- * Recent heat bill
- * Recent electric bill

WAGE EARNERS:

- * Please bring copies of your check stubs for the 30-day period preceding the date of application, or a copy of your federal tax return

FIXED INCOME:

- * This income may include: Social Security Benefits, Supplemental Security Income, Family Investment Program, Veteran's Assistance, Unemployment Insurance and pensions. Please bring copies of check stubs from the previous 30 days

SELF-EMPLOYED FARMERS:

- * Bring a copy of the most recent federal tax return

FIP RECIPIENTS:

- * Bring current DHS Notice of Decision or contact local office for document information
