### WINTER REMINDER

**Parking Snow Ban**--Between Nov 1<sup>st</sup> and Mar. 31<sup>st</sup> no vehicle shall be left standing or parked on City streets between the hours of 2:00am and 6:00am or at any time during the day or night in which snow removal operations are in progress. Fines for 1<sup>st</sup> offense will be \$25. For all subsequent offenses, the fine will be \$50

**Dumping of Snow**-- It is unlawful for any person to throw, push, or place or cause to be thrown, pushed or placed, any ice or snow from private property, sidewalks, or driveways onto the traveled way of a street or alley.

Garbage containers are to be placed at the curb, not on the street. Once garbage has been picked up the carts need to be moved back to your house not left at the curb.

Be sure to check if your furnace filter needs replacement. Stop in the Utility office to pick up your replacement filter. Limit 2 per year.

### Garbage Pick-up Change

Due to Christmas and New Year's falling on a Friday garbage pickup will be on Thursday for those two weeks. For those two weeks the pickup dates will be **Dec. 24** and **Dec 31**.

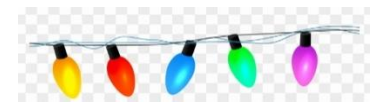
