SEWER RATE INCREASE

The construction of the sewer treatment plant continues to progress on schedule. New sewer rates have been established and will take effect July 1, which means the increase will be seen on the July usage bill. The new rates will be as follows:

Monthly service fee:	\$12.75
Per 1000 gals. Water	\$6.00
Capital Improve.t fee	\$23.00

As a city we will do all that we can to keep cost as low as possible and run the plant as efficient as we can. All these costs will be closely monitored. The rate fees will be reviewed annually, and adjustments will be made each July 1 as needed.
