CITY WIDE CLEAN-UP

The city-wide clean-up is scheduled for April 29th. This clean-up is for residential areas only. All items must be placed at the curb by 7:00am. Tags must be purchased for the following items:

Household appliance.....	\$25
Electronics.....	\$11
Mattress/Box Spring.....	\$11
TV (based on size).....	\$20 to \$30
Computer Monitor.....	\$20
Couches & Recliners.....	\$10
Chairs/Dresser/TV Stand.....	\$ 5
Bldg Materials/Wood Products.....	\$10
Tires (no rims).....	\$5 to \$25

We ask that you separate your items in the following groups: Appliances, furniture, metal & iron, building materials. Regular household garbage will need to be in the trash carts. Metal & iron should be no longer than 10ft. Building materials should be tied in 3x3x3 bundles. All glass must be removed from windows and doors. Items that require tags will not be picked up if a tag is not purchased.

The following items **will not be accepted**: toxic/flammable liquids, concrete, rocks, brick, yard waste (grasses, flowers, etc.) and tree branches.

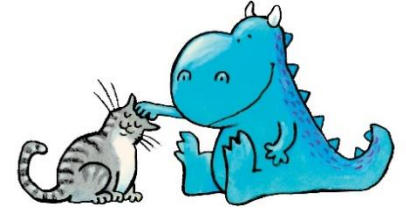
