

Sewer Rate Increase

The construction of the sewer treatment plant is close to being completed. It will be operational no later than Sept 2022. An additional increase in the sewer rate will take effect July 1, which means the increase will be seen on the July usage bill. The new rates will be as follows:

Monthly service fee:	\$21.70
Per 1000 gals. Water	\$10.20
Capital improvement fee	\$26.00

As a city we will do all that we can to keep cost as low as possible and run the plant as efficient as we can. All these costs will be closely monitored. The rate fees will be reviewed annually, and adjustments will be made each July 1 as needed.

CITY REMINDER

Your home and property are one of the greatest assets you will ever own. Here are a few things that your property **IS NOT**

1. It is not a prairie, hence the need to keep it mowed and trimmed; including weeds.
2. It is not a used car lot or a salvage/ junk yard. Both of those require a special sales permit. Vehicles not being used need to be removed from the property. As for junk it just plain needs to be removed.
3. Your yard is not an open storage unit. The ordinance has limited items that can be stored in the side and back yard. This includes trailers, boats, campers, etc. Check the ordinance. There are storage units available for rent.
4. Your property is not a campground. Campers can only have human occupancy for a total of 14 days per year.
