

Sewer Plant Update

The start up of the sewer plant has been slightly delayed. Originally the plan was to do a dry-run the week of Sept. 19. This would be done to test all the equipment, programming, etc. to be sure everything is functioning as it should before raw sewage is released into the new plant. This has been pushed back to the week of Oct. 3. If the dry-run goes well the new plant should be operational by the end of October. Before the change in the dry-run date we had planned an open house for the second week of October. With the timeline push back it will likely be too late in the season to plan an open house due to weather. The current plan is to wait and have an open house in the spring.

WHEN TO APPLY

- * Elderly (60 & over) & disabled: Oct.1, 2022 to Apr. 30, 2023
- * All other households: Nov.1, 2022 to Apr. 30, 2023

WHAT TO TAKE

- * Proof of Income (for all household members age 18 & over). Depending upon your household income type, income documentation from the past 30 days, last 12 months, or last calendar year, whichever is easier or more beneficial for you.
- * Social Security numbers for all household members (documentation required).
- * Most recent heat bill.
- * Most recent electric bill.

WAGE EARNERS

- * Bring copies of your check stubs for the 30-day period preceding the date of application, or a copy of your most recent federal income tax return.

FIXED INCOME

- * This income may include: Social Security Benefits, Supplemental Security Income, Veteran's Assistance, Unemployment Insurance, and pensions. Bring copies of your check stubs from the previous 30 days.

SELF-EMPLOYED/FARMERS

- * Bring a copy of your most recent federal income tax return.

Additional income not listed here may be required.
